CSC are pleased to present the 2nd reserve deployment drill day to assist with familiarisation of your emergency reserve systems. You can practice reserve drills in a static hanger and then up to 3 dummy reserve deployments on a 170m long Zip Line with rotations and tasks to ramp up muscle memory regarding location of your reserve handle, Malcolm Grout will time you.

Please arrive at least 15 mins before your allocated time to sign in and prepare in good time. All participants will be asked to sign a disclaimer.

You need to bring your BHPA card, harness, helmet, gloves and radio if you have one.

Static throw from harness hanger coaching and induction with Richard Bungay and Patrick Holmes to check your reserve deployment and then replace your

reserve container with a dummy unit for practice throws on the zip line. You will do this yourself on second and third runs with coaches available to assist and offer feedback.

Up to 3 Zip Runs with various scenarios to stress test you and enhance your confidence to reach, find and throw your reserve in a reliable and confident way while being distracted by evolving situations. Live feedback from coaches and a chance to chat with experienced pilots that have deployed in anger.

Back to refit area to replace your reserve container under supervision of the BHPA repack team.
